## Collaboration: Redefining Our Future

COVID-19 pandemic hit the City of Jakarta harshly, resulted in heavy dead tolls 1,365 by 11 September 2020. As a major entry point of Indonesia, it was obvious Jakarta becomes the epicenter of the outbreak since March 2020. The Provincial Government of Jakarta was challenged to mitigate the health crisis with very limited resources and capacity, especially during the early days of the outbreak, due to high competition for medical resources globally.

With such limitations, collaboration becomes the most effective way to deliver essential needs. Citizens of Jakarta showed their solidarity, hundreds of collaborators contributed to provide medical and logistic goods in helping the city government to cover the essentials within a very short time. Epidemiologists consistently support with policy recommendations, while laboratories collaborate to provide faster results of diagnostic tests. Hotel and transportation corporations provide accommodations and transports for medical workers.

The government and citizens are hand-in-hand providing helps to mitigate the disaster and its socio-economic impacts. The National Government supports policy direction and the city's essentials, including staple food during social distancing periods. Within the neighborhood level, the wealthy provides free foods voluntarily for those heavily affected. Companies cut the salaries of some to keep the others work.

It does not stop there. The closing of schools initiates multiple collaborative remote-educational platforms. Telecommunication provider contributes to give free wifi across the city. Even the friendship is crossed borders. Sister cities help Jakarta in difficult times. With collaboration, Jakarta can survive.

Against these backdrops, The JDCN Forum 2020 will be the first annual forum on collaboration issues held by the Government of Jakarta under the new city brand: +Jakarta. The event aims to commemorate, discuss, and inspire collaborations in the capital city.

#### Concept

Using the theme 'Collaboration: Redefining Our Future', the event is aware of the disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic that have forced societies to find a way to redefine their future. While a business-as-usual may not enough, collaboration opens many unexplored possibilities to redesign our future.

The JDCN Forum 2020 will be a 100% online event that will be accessible for the public via the +Jakarta website and other platforms. The main event will be aired on 17 and 18 December 2020.

An International Plenary Discussion will be a part of the JDCN Forum 2020 which will be an event to sharing the knowledge between regional leaders and experts to reassess the cities' challenges and opportunities during and after the pandemic.
